Short Term Rentals

Forest Pines Deed Restrictions do not allow for Air BnB short term rentals. The neighborhood is zoned for single family dwellings only.

Parking Vehicles in Yards is Against City Ordinances



Violating the Ordinance by having a car parked in the yard is a misdemeanor, enforced by HPD, and violators will receive a fine not to exceed **\$150.00 a day**.

City of Houston Ordinance 2009-1003 extends the provision of Section 28-303 of the Code of Ordinances, Houston, Texas to various singlefamily residential properties with Forest Pines Subdivision, Sections 1, 2A, and 2B, to prohibit the parking of vehicles in yards.
